CALL FOR ABSTRACTS

The Interchange Program Committee is now accepting abstracts for presentations for the CDISC 2010 North America Interchange to be held in Baltimore, MD, USA, on 3-4 November.

Several sessions are planned with oral presentations lasting approximately 20 minutes and there will also be poster sessions over the two days. CDISC would like to receive abstracts in areas such as the following, or any area related to CDISC standards implementation for medical research, including terminology.

Therapeutic Area Standards Development

Abstracts would be welcomed from those working on the augmentation of the CDISC safety standards in new therapeutic (efficacy) areas, including devices and imaging.

CDISC Submission Standards

Case studies and lessons learned for the following, particularly implementation experiences.

- SDTM
- SEND
- ADaM

Implementation of CDISC standards

Adoption and implementation of CDISC standards by therapeutic or device product development organizations, academic institutions other medical researchers. Case studies and lessons learned for the following: ODM, Define.xml, LAB, CDASH, Protocol, Terminology, BRIDG, SDTM, SEND, ADaM, RFD or any combination of these.

CDASH and Protocol

Focus on standards from the start, with case studies and implementation examples that demonstrate the benefits of the standards and improvements to process.

The CDISC End to End Solution from eSource to Reporting

Demonstrating the value case for time and resource savings across the CDISC standards, starting with the integration of clinical research and healthcare (EHR) systems. Case studies of any integration used for clinical studies or medical research with lessons learned. Solutions that demonstrate the accelerating research processes through standards.

Poster Sessions

Posters would be welcomed in relation to all the CDISC standards, including those areas outlined in this call. Some abstracts that are not chosen for presentations may well be offered a poster session.
